



3 NIGHTS - 4 DAYS GAME SAFARI MURCHISON FALLS

SAFARI OVERVIEW

Murchison Falls National Park (MFNP) is situated at the northern end of the Great Rift Valley and was one of the first national parks established in 1952. With a size of 3,900 square kilometers, MFNP is also the largest park in Uganda, featuring extraordinary biodiversity and landscapes ranging from savannahs, riverine wetlands as defined by the river Nile and tropical forests. One of the most important landscape attractions within the park is the Nile Delta wetlands system that formed when the river reached the northern shores of Lake Albert. Its primary attraction, however, remains the famous Murchison Falls, whose massive 43-meter falls of boiling water is forced through a 7-meter wide gap before crashing into the lightly wooded savannah below.

The park and the adjacent Budongo Forest Reserve feature 76 species of mammals, including chimpanzees, as well as Uganda's largest population of Nile crocodiles. Also, more than 450 bird species have been recorded in this area. Our 4 Days Murchison Falls Game Safari offers you an amazing variety of wildlife, including lions, elephants, hippos, crocodiles, and the elusive shoebill stork. The last stop of your safari is the Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary offering you the exhilarating experience of tracking rhinos on foot.

Day 1 - Kampala to Murchison Falls National Park

Transfer to Murchison Falls National Park. Game drive.

Day 2 - Murchison Falls National Park

Game drive. Boat cruise and hike to the top of the falls.

Day 3 - Murchison Falls National Park

Game drive. Nile delta boat cruise. Chimp tracking in Budongo forest.

Day 4 - Murchison Falls National Park to Kampala

Transfer back to Kampala.

SAFARI ITINERARY

Day 1 - Kampala to Murchison Falls National Park

Murchison Falls National Park (MFNP) is situated at the northern end of the Great Rift Valley and was one of the first national parks established in 1952. With a size of 3,900 square kilometers, MFNP is also the largest park in Uganda, featuring extraordinary biodiversity and landscapes ranging from savannahs, riverine wetlands as defined by the river Nile and tropical forests. The park itself is part of the even larger Murchison Falls Protected Area that covers more than 5,000 square kilometers and includes the Karuma Falls and the Bugungu Wildlife Refuge. One of the most important attractions within the park is the Nile Delta wetlands system that formed when the river reached the northern shores of Lake Albert. Its primary attraction, however, remains the famous Murchison Falls, whose massive 43-meter falls of boiling water is forced through a 7-meter wide gap before crashing into the lightly wooded savannah below.

Various lodges in the park offer daily boat trips along the Nile with the opportunity to see Murchison Falls up close or venture into the Nile Delta on the edge of Lake Albert, with the chance to see a spectacular variety of wildlife such as elephants, hippos, crocodiles and an impressive variety of tropical birds such as the rare and elusive shoebill stork.

The following optional activities at cost are available for the Murchison Falls National Park. Please see the section [Services & Safari Activities Included](#) for optional activities included in the price for this itinerary.

Optional Activity - Boat Cruise to the Falls: One of the highlights of your visit to Murchison Falls National Park is the boat cruise for a close-up view of the Murchison Falls while observing the wildlife found along the river banks.

Optional Activity - Hiking to the Top of the Falls: You can go on a hike to the falls as a further option at the end of the boat cruise. The hike starts at the bottom of the falls at Baker's Point, where the famous explorer in 1864 named the falls after Sir Roderick Murchison, the then president of the Royal Geographical Society.

Optional Activity - Nile Delta Boat Cruise: Another fantastic opportunity to discover the amazing wildlife along the river banks is the boat cruise to the Nile Delta wetlands system. The delta formed when the river reached the northern shores of Lake Albert and is home to elephants, hippos, crocodiles, and a range of rare wetland birds, including the famous shoebill stork.

Optional Activity - Hot Air Balloon Safaris: You have the additional opportunity for an early morning balloon trip over the savannah, silently gliding above the tree-tops to observe the wildlife below. This balloon safari includes a bush breakfast at the end of the flight.



Optional Activity - Chimpanzee Tracking Budongo Forest: You can further participate in an exhilarating search for chimp troops in the Budongo Forest with the further opportunity of observing an impressive number of tropical bird species in their natural habitat.

Optional Activity - Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary: The rhino sanctuary is not directly a part of the Murchison Falls National Park but can be visited on the way to the park. Here, you have the opportunity to track rhinos accompanied by wildlife guides.

Day 2 - Murchison Falls National Park

The park and the adjacent Budongo Forest Reserve feature 76 species of mammals, including chimpanzees, buffalos, lions, elephants, Uganda kob, Rothschild's giraffe, and the largest population of Nile crocodiles in the country. Also, more than 450 bird species have been documented in this national park. The southern sector of the park features the Budongo Forest Reserve, home to over 600 chimps and one of the most ecologically diverse areas in the region, with over 460 plant species recorded, including an area of giant mahogany trees reaching up to 60 meters tall.
